## POLYMYALGIA RHEUMATICA AND GIANT CELL ARTERITIS

Polymyalgia Rheumatica (PMR) is an inflammatory condition of unknown cause. It is recognised to be autoimmune illness. It causes pain, tenderness and stiffness in the large muscles around the shoulders, hips and back. It mainly affects people over the age of 50 with the peak being in the 7th and 8th decades of life, it tends to affect far more women than men. While some people recover after a year or two of treatment with corticosteroids, gradually reducing these steroids as guided by our doctors. It is vital that their advice is followed.
