CHECK YOUR MOLES

Every year the practice refers many patients to the West Suffolk Hospital Dermatology team with moles and skin lesions that have changed in size or colour, to check for possible skin cancer. Most of the moles and lesions assessed are not cancerous but many are and we recommend that you check any moles or skin lesions you have in case they are changing in order to get them checked. If you are concerned, please contact the practice to book an appointment. It goes without saying that the dangers of exposure to the sun are well known so please do cover up and/ or use sun tan lotion regularly to protect yourself and your family, and not just if you are travelling abroad on holiday.

DIRECT BOOKING FOR VACCINATIONS & CLINICS VIA SMS TEXT

For patients who have given permission to contact them by text, the practice are increasing the use of direct booking into appointments when responding to appropriate text invites. This avoids the need for patients to have to phone to book appointments (although they can still call if they wish to speak to the surgery regarding the text invite) and it means patients can organise these appointments out of surgery hours for convenience. For some services, for example flu and covid vaccination invites, you are asked to either book an appointment or decline the service offered, please do respond as it helps the practice to ensure there are enough appointments available for those patients wanting that service, and also it helps the clinical teams to order the correct number of vaccines.

If you haven't yet signed up to receive text invites and reminders then please do so, thank you.

MISSED APPOINTMENTS

UNFORTUNATELY, 300 APPOINTMENTS A MONTH ARE MISSED.

A text is sent to your mobile phone just after you have made the appointment and again the day before. If, however, you cannot attend, please telephone to cancel so that an urgent request by another patient to see a doctor or nurse can be given. A receptionist always tries to follow up a missed appointment.

If you have not given the surgery your mobile number, please consider passing it on.

BYSTANDER CPR TRAINING

As part of the British Heart Foundation Nation of Lifesavers and CPR (Call Push Rescue) campaign, this training is now offered and delivered as part of the West Suffolk Community Cardiac Rehab program. Every year over 30,000 cardiac arrests happen out of hospital in the UK alone, with only 1 in 10 surviving. 80% of out of hospital cardiac arrests happen at home and 20% in public places.
