#### 1.0 Welcomes, Introductions and Apologies

#### 2.0 Minutes of last meeting 7<sup>th</sup> August

Everyone happy with the minutes of the last meeting.

PW gave an update on the bid to obtain the Baker's Mill Development Section 106 monies to contribute toward funding a bus service to the Sudbury Health Centre (SHC). It is understood that the Bakers Mill 106 monies could not be used to fund a bus service as the monies could only be used for the benefit of Bakers Mill. There was an indication that one of the bus companies was considering a route change to include the SHC but no confirmation of this or date was given.

**Post meeting Note:** PW raised the issue of transport to the Sudbury Health Centre with 2 Babergh Councillors who recently visited a Sudbury Area Cancer Support Meeting. They indicated the discussions over section 106 monies were not dead yet, and they would add their weight to the cause.

#### 2.1 Meeting 24<sup>th</sup> July 2015

JS explained that he had met with PW, NG, and SB on 24<sup>th</sup> July for a discussion on how the group should develop in the future. Issues discussed / agreed;

- Need to make meetings more efficient – don't talk unless invited by chair.
- NG to be Communications Lead identifying groups the PPG needed to communicate with.
- SB / PW to develop PPG Newsletter
- JS to be Liaison Lead with Practice Manager and GPs.

#### 3.0 Updates

##### 3.1 Hardwicke House Practice

- **IPSOS Mori CCGs and GPs Survey** - DC said a survey had recently been carried out of CCGs and GPs. Results for the HH practice were average, and for Suffolk above average. SP asked if this referred to specific items of healthcare. DC said he would distribute report to PPG members. Link to report.

- **Integrated Care Option (ICO)** - DC said GP practices in the WS CCG area had opted for the ICO. This involves Hospitals working with GPs, not Hospitals taking over GPs or vice versa. MC said politicians wanted GPs to manage healthcare, SP said this was OK but they needed time

and resources to do it. DC said that from talking to Proff. Dr Stephen Dunn (CEO WSH) he had confidence this would move.

- **New HH Premises** – Struggle with NHS England, they were not sympathetic to project as they had just provided £5M of funding for the new Sudbury Health Centre (SHC). DC pointed out HH was not in competition with the SHC. DC said he may ask the PPG to lobby Politicians and MP. Developers have put a bid for Belle Vue, this was separate from the Community Asset bid. Current Landlords HH, ML and Bures - PHP, GC and Clare – Private individuals.
- **GP recruitment** - SP said recruitment was going well, nice environment, GPs returning. Sophie Ruddock and Stephen Fry had recently married. Dr Jetha retiring.
