DON'T LET YOUR CHILD CATCH IT IMMUNISATION THE SAFEST WAY TO PROTECT YOUR CHILD

The number of children catching measles is rising across the United Kingdom and Europe. Your child should receive MMR vaccinations just after their first birthday, and again at three years and four months or soon after - best before starting school. If your child has missed one of their routine MMR vaccinations, you can make an appointment with your GP to get it. It is never too late to have your child vaccinated.

Children under the age of 18 years who have missed their MMR vaccination should have the vaccine.

If you or someone you know has Parkinson's, then you may be interested to know that there's a local support group operating in this area. The Sudbury Independent Parkinson's Group (SIPG) meets at the Stephenson Centre in Great Cornard on the third Wednesday of each month and we're looking for new members. The SIPG seeks to build friendships and share experiences

Unlike most other infections, you don't catch shingles from someone else. Most of us had chickenpox when we were young, although some of us will not be aware that we've had it. After you have chickenpox, the virus remains dormant living in the nerves.

For most of your life you will not be aware of this, but from time to time the virus can come back and spread to the skin causing a disease called shingles.

Shingles can occur at any age but the risk, severity and complications increase with age By having the vaccination, you will significantly reduce your chance of developing shingles.

HOW TO REGISTER AND GET FULL USE OF NHS APP SERVICES

I<u>nstalling the app</u> <u>Registering</u>

Open the App Store or Google Play/Search for 'NHS App'/Install the app. If you already have an NHS login account for other apps and websites you

can use the same email address and password to log in. To create an NHS login account, you must be aged 13 or over, and have an email address and phone number:

- 1 Enter your email address and select Continue.
- 2 Choose a password. Accept the NHS login terms and conditions.
- 3 We will email you a security code. Enter this code in the NHS App to confirm your email address Enter your mobile phone number and select Continue.
- 4 We will send you another security code in a text message. Enter this code in the NHS App to confirm your mobile phone number.
- 5 If you have entered the correct codes, you can access the NHS App.
